Statute 734

The Liturgies of the Word Amendment Confirmation Statute, 2018.

Whereas:

- (a) The General Synod/Te Hīnota Whānui 2016 enacted as Statute number 728 'The Liturgies of the Word Amendment Statute, 2016', in terms of Part B, Clause 6(a) of the Constitution/Te Pouhere, and Section 4(a) of the Church of England Empowering Act 1928 to authorise amendments to the Formularies, and
- (b) Te Runanganui o Te Pīhopatanga o Aotearoa, the Synod of the Diocese of Polynesia, and a majority of the Diocesan Synods in New Zealand have assented to the proposal pursuant to Part B, Clause 6(b) of the Constitution/Te Pouhere, and Section 4(b) of the Church of England Empowering Act 1928, and
- (c) Since the adoption of this proposal, there has been a fresh election of members of the General Synod/Te Hīnota Whānui.

The General Synod/te Hīnota Whānui enacts as follows:

- **1. Title.** The title of this Statute shall be *The Liturgies of the Word Amendment Confirmation Statute,* 2018.
- 2. The proposal contained in Statute 728 to amend the Liturgies of the Word to include a Māori version of The Grace in The Liturgies of the Word, is agreed to.
- 3. The provisions on page 52 of A New Zealand Prayer Book He Karakia Mihinare o Aotearoa after the words "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all. Amen." are amended with the following words inserted:

Kia tau ki a tātou katoa te atawhai o tō tātou Ariki, o Īhu Karaiti, me te aroha o te Atua, me te whiwhinga tahitanga ki te Wairua Tapu, āke ake ake. Āmine.
