Statute 743

The Title B Canon XXXV Amendment Statute, 2018

Whereas, General Synod/Te Hīnota Whānui in 2006 enacted Statute 660 to establish the Council for Anglican Women's Studies (CAWS) through Title B Canon XXXV, and

Whereas, General Synod Standing Committee, as part of a schedule for regular review of three-tikanga bodies, invited CAWS to review the Canon for fitness for current purpose, and

Whereas, the lack of continuity of membership has hampered the Council's projects and progress,

The General Synod te Hīnota Whānui enacts as follows:

- 1. Title. The Title of this Statute is The Title B Canon XXXV Amendment Statute, 2018.
- **2. Purpose.** To amend Title B Canon XXXV to update its provisions.
- **3.** Title B Canon XXXV is amended by:

In clause 5, deleting the words of the clause and inserting the words -

- **5. Members.** The Council will have six members appointed for terms of four years with three members appointed at each ordinary session of the General Synod/te Hīnota Whānui: -
- i. One member nominated by Te Runanga Whaiti o Te Pīhopatanga o Aotearoa
- ii. One member nominated by the Tikanga Pākehā Conference Co-ordinating Group
- iii. One member nominated by the Standing Committee of the Diocese of Polynesia

after appropriate consultation with women's organizations within the Church/Te Hāhi Mihinare.

For the 2020 election the Council will decide which of the current members' terms come to an end in 2020 with the terms of the remaining members coming to an end in 2022.

4. Commencement: This Statute comes into effect at the close of the session of General Synod/te Hīnota Whānui at which it is passed.
